INTRODUCTION

The violence within the American domicile has been recognized for decades by elements of government and society with little done to correct the problem. Only recently has this phenomenon begun to receive the attention it deserves. In an effort to understand, identify and treat the incidents of abuse occurring in the home, the State of New Jersey, through its legislature, has provided the means to gain a meaningful insight into this issue.

In 1982, the Domestic Violence Act was instituted to protect battered victims and study the complex problems that spark such aggressive behavior. This legislation also provided the opportunity to identify the causes of violence in the home and put forth a more comprehensive effort to combat the crime of Domestic Violence.

Improvements since the implementation of the Domestic Violence Act are continuing. Pursuant to a change in N.J.S.A. 2C:25-24 enacted June 9, 1999, arrest data is presented by county. Domestic Violence restraining order violations are now captured and reported. Revised investigation and reporting procedures by the police; improved processing of domestic complaints by the courts; mandatory in-service training for police and court personnel have all enabled the victim to come forward and implement the constitutional rights granted to all Americans.

The following pages of narrative and graphics in this chapter are the result of gathered data displaying the complexities of domestic violence found within the State of New Jersey. It is through analysis of this data that, hopefully, the keys to preventing future violence can be found.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE STATISTICAL SUMMARY

Highlights of the 2013 domestic violence statistics are listed below:

- There were 64,556 domestic violence offenses reported by the police in 2013, a 1 percent decrease compared to the 65,060 reported in 2012.
- Murders increased 13 percent in 2013 (44) when compared to 2012 (38).
- Assaults accounted for 43 percent (27,647) and harassment accounted for 43 percent (27,704) of the reported offenses in 2013.
- Arrests were made in 31 percent (20,178) of the offenses reported for 2013, a decrease of 1 percent when compared to arrests made in 2012.
- The most frequent day of domestic violence occurrences was Sunday (11,235).
- For the thirty-first consecutive year, the most frequent hours of domestic violence incidents were between 8:00 p.m. and midnight, when 25 percent (16,340) of the offenses were reported.
- Children were involved or present during 30 percent of all domestic violence offenses occurring in 2013. Specifically, 5 percent (2,916) were involved and 25 percent (16,149) were present.
- Wives were the victims in 16 percent (10,158) and ex-wives were the victims in 3 percent (2,167) of the reported domestic violence offenses in 2013. Overall, females were victims in 75 percent (48,305) of all domestic violence offenses.
- The number of domestic violence complaints that had prior court orders issued against the offender decreased from 11,494 in 2012 to 10,929 in 2013. This is a decrease of 5 percent.
- Alcohol and/or drugs were involved in 26 percent (16,751) of the reported offenses occurring in 2013. Alcohol involvement alone accounted for 23 percent (14,917) of the total domestic violence offenses reported.
- Persons age 60 or over (elderly) were victims in 5 percent (3,239) of all reported domestic violence offenses that occurred in 2013 and were the victims in 25 percent (11) of the domestic violence murders (44).
- Domestic violence does not occur at a regular frequency, but when viewed as a ratio of its occurrence to a fixed time interval, one act of domestic violence would occur every 8 minutes and 14 seconds.
- Domestic violence offenses arising from a dating relationship accounted for 15 percent (9,444) of the state total.
- There were 2,441 total arrests involving domestic violence restraining orders reported by police in 2013. Of these, 1,409 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **only**, while 1,032 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **with** an offense arrest.

- Twenty-seven percent (17,346) of all domestic violence complaints resulted in injury. This is an increase of 1 percent when compared to the 17,093 that occurred in 2012.
- Of all the domestic violence offenses involving weapons (29,655) hands, fists, feet, etc. were used in 92 percent (27,161) of these offenses.
- Domestic violence offenses involving a gun increased 10 percent when compared to 2012.
- Serious injuries were reported in 1,323 offenses, an increase of 8 percent when compared to the 1,221 reported in 2012.





DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENSES BY TIME OF DAY 2012/2013




- During 2013, 25 percent (16,340) of the reported domestic violence offenses occurred between 8:00 p.m. and 12 midnight.
