

Introduction

The New Jersey State Police Major Crime Unit, the New Jersey Homicide Investigator's Association, and the Princeton University Department of Public Safety cordially invite you to participate in our Sixteenth Annual Advanced Homicide Investigation Conference. The conference will be held on the campus of Princeton University.

The conference is designed to meet the needs of investigators and supervisors tasked with the investigation of homicides, suicides and unnatural deaths. Topics of discussion include gunshot wounds, cutting wounds, blunt force wounds, infant death, interview and interrogation, shooting reconstruction, blood spatter analysis, forensic linguistics and the behavioral analysis of homicide investigation as well as major case studies.

All attendees will receive a comprehensive notebook containing writings and information supplied by the speakers. In addition, attendees will have ample opportunity to discuss their own cases with investigators from across the United States and several foreign nations. We have designed the conference to provide social activities which facilitate networking and small group discussions between the attendees.

Course Information

DATE: JUNE 22 - 26, 2009

Registration will be from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM on Sunday, June 21, 2009, at the Historic Nassau Inn located in Princeton University, and from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM at the Frist Center on June 22, 2009.

LOCATION

All classroom lecture will be held on the lower floor of the Frist Center on the grounds of Princeton University, Princeton, New Jersey. The educational part of the conference will be held in

the conference rooms on the lower floor of the Frist Campus Center. A food court, university store, and other amenities are located on the second floor of the Frist Campus Center.

CONFERENCE TUITION

The conference tuition is \$495. This includes the conference book and other learning materials. A well stocked continental breakfast, morning coffee break, and afternoon snack break are included in the tuition. In addition, tuition includes Monday and Wednesday evening receptions and Thursday evening banquet, as well as social activities.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

On Monday, conference attendees are invited to attend a buffet reception immediately following the Cold Case Review Workshop. On Tuesday, conference attendees will be bused to Liberty State Park for a private tour of the Statue of Liberty. Transportation from Liberty State Park will be provided by the New Jersey State Police Marine Police. On Wednesday evening, a workshop on media relations pertaining to homicide investigations will be held which will include a social reception. On Thursday evening, conference attendees are invited to attend a banquet at the Prospect House, a mansion located on the Princeton University campus.
